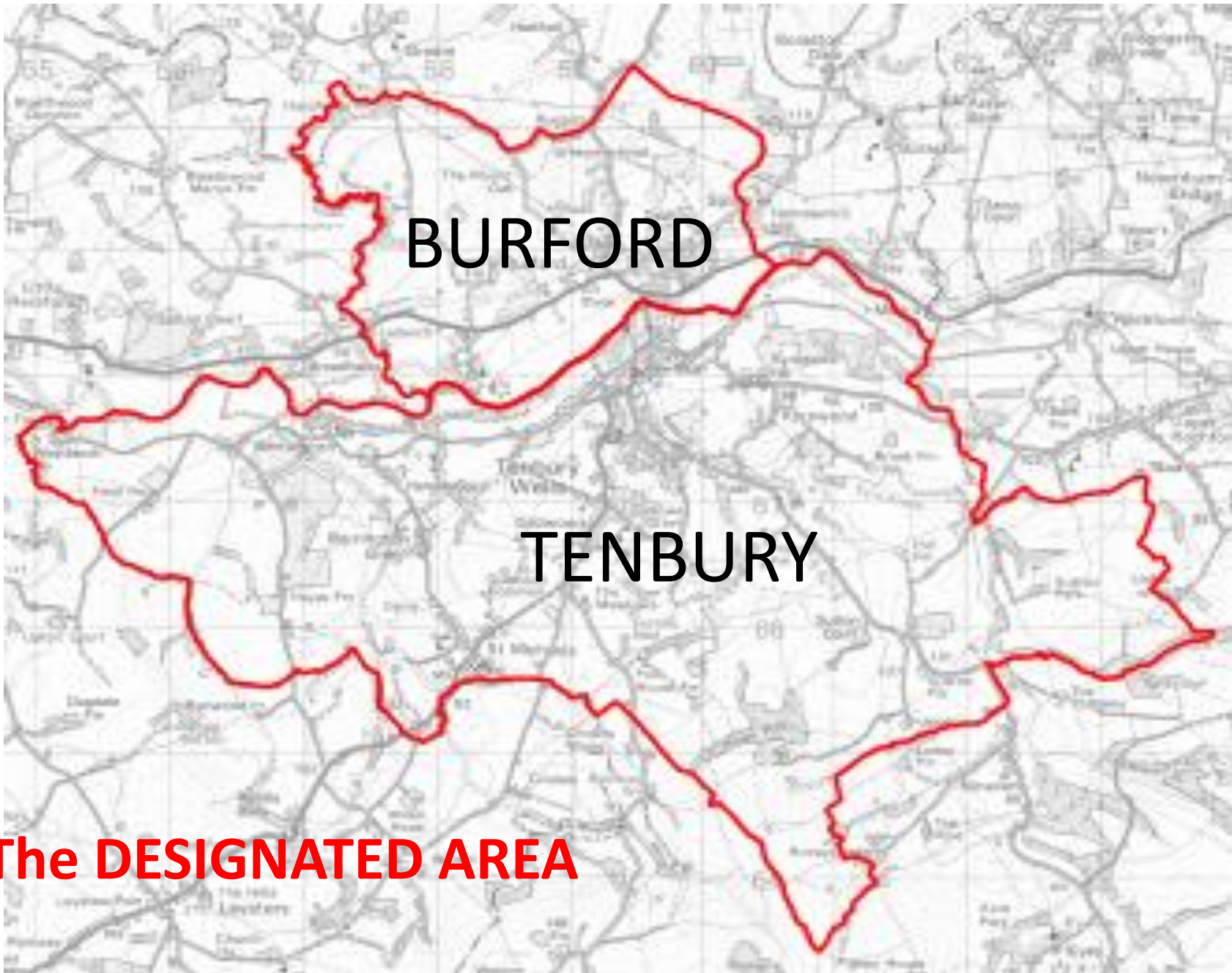

What stage are we at?

The first steps have already been taken

- Burford and Tenbury Councils have agreed to prepare a joint plan so that our community is looked at as one whole regardless of County boundaries.
- A Neighbourhood Area has been designated (sign off is imminent)

What stage are we at?

- A Steering Group has been set up to manage the process
- Consultants have been appointed to guide everyone through the process and help with writing the final plan
- Government Grant Funding has been applied for and awarded to help cover the plan preparation costs.
- A vision statement has been agreed



Our vision for Tenbury and Burford is one of a strong, thriving and healthy community where both the quality of the built environment and the rural character of the settlements is preserved and enhanced for the enjoyment of people of all ages.

THE STEERING GROUP - principle role is to:

- Define a draft vision and objectives for the NP.
- Define the scope of work needed to develop the NP.
- Develop a project and communications plan for delivery of the NP.
- Manage resources and budget to deliver the NP.
- Organise and oversee working groups to deliver the range of activities needed to develop the NP.
- Report on progress to the Councils; submit key outputs for approval.
- Maintain communication and collaboration with Malvern Hills District Council planners.
- Identify external resources, if required, to assist or advise on the NP presentation

FIVE THEMES

- Built and Natural Environment incl. Housing and Flooding
- Agriculture, Business & Tourism
- Roads, Traffic and Parking
- Community, Public Buildings and Services
- Public Transport and Broadband

THEMED WORKING GROUPS - principle role is to:

- Spread the word - neighbours, friends, family, work colleagues, group members, employees etc
- Help identify what the main issues are.
- Consider possible approaches to deal with these issues.
- Consult with local residents and businesses and stakeholders holders for their views.
- Prepare draft content - for the sections of the plan.
- Contribute content for communication and consultation documents for public meetings, drop-in's, exhibitions, leafleting etc.

What can you do?
